We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the State of Texas, acting as incorporators of a corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Association") under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Act"), do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such Association:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Association is: Belle Park Community Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Non-Profit

The Association is a Non-Profit Corporation.

ARTICLE III

Duration

The period of the duration of the Association is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

Purposes

Section 1 - Purposes. The Association is not organized for profit to the members thereof but, rather, is organized and shall be operated exclusively for the promotion of social welfare within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as that Section of the Code now exists or as hereafter amended, and in furtherance of such purposes, but always subservient thereto, such purpose shall include the following:

- (a) To promote peace and tranquility within the neighborhoods of
 - (b) To promote camaraderie among its members.

- (c) To maintain or upgrade the quality of the neighborhood's environment.
- (d) To furnish aid and comfort to its members, in their time or times of need and distress.
 - (e) To promote well-being and patiotism among its members.
- (f) To perform services for members (except services requiring a license which cannot lawfully be granted to this corporation).
- (g) To do and and all things necessarily incident to the fulfillment of the foregoing purposes.

ARTICLE V

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE and INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE VI

Data Respecting Directors
